

**Memo No. STA/2-PM Gr.II/2017 dated at Chennai 600 002 the 24.04.2017**

The competent authority has ordered promotion for the following Postmaster Grade I Cadre officials, to the cadre of Postmaster Grade II on regular basis in the prervised Pay Band 2 Rs.9,300 –34,800 with Grade pay of Rs. 4,200 and further ordered their allotment to Region as shown against each with immediate effect and until further orders.

2. The under mentioned official (Sl.No.5 in para above) is debarred for promotion to PM Grade II cadre on regular basis upto 24.10.2017. She may be promoted only after her debarment period is over.

3. The officials against whom any punishment is current they should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. Accordingly, following official (Sl.No.6 in para 1) may be promoted only after his punishment period is over.

4. The promotion of the above mentioned officials in Postmaster Grade II Cadre will take effect from the date on which the officials actually join the post of Postmaster Grade II Cadre.

5. Further career progression will be in the hierarchy in the Postmaster Cadre only as per the provisions in the relevant Recruitment Rules and not in General Line.

6. Under the provision contained in OM no.F-7/1/80-Estt dated 26/09/81 of Department of Personnel and training, New Delhi incorporated in Govt of India order below FR 22, the officials who are promoted on regular basis are entitled to exercise an option for fixation of pay on promotion under FR 22 (1) a (1) on the date of promotion or on the date of accrual of next increment in the scale of pay in lower post. The option in this regard should be exercised within one month from the date of promotion. Option once exercised is final. The officials now promoted on regular basis are not entitled for any pay fixation in the pay band and Grade pay applicable to PM Grade-II Cadre if they have already availed the benefit of financial upgradation under TBOP/BCR Scheme/MACP Scheme. Pay may be fixed in accordance with applicable pay matrix introduced in 7<sup>th</sup> CPC.

7. The Regions concerned will issue transfer and posting orders within 3 days from the date of this order.



8. The Region will specifically mention in the Transfer and posting orders, whether the transfer will be for a period exceeding 180 days or not exceeding 180 days to ensure economy in expenditure on account of payment of TA/DA in case of the officials retiring shortly on superannuation after joining the promotional post.
9. The appointing authority reserves the right either to modify or cancel the promotion, if the officials are found not eligible for promotion as Postmaster Grade II or if found necessary for any cause at a later date.
10. In case, if any official is not willing to accept the promotion, his / her unconditional declination letter should be obtained within 15 days from the date of issue of posting/transfer orders on promotion. The declination letter, if any, will be disposed by the Appointing Authority concerned. The official declining the promotion will lose seniority vis-à-vis his juniors promoted to PM Grade-II cadre and he/she will be considered for promotion only after one year, from the date of declination or on availability of next vacancy whichever is later, subject to all other conditions prescribed.
11. In case any Vigilance / Disciplinary case, of the type referred to in O.M. No. 22011/2/86 – Estt. (A) dated 12.01.88 and DOP&T circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25 – 19/88 – SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP & T Memo No. 22011/4/91 – Estt (A) dated 14.09.92 circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25 -19/88 – SPG dated 13.10.92 is pending against any of the above mentioned officials, they should not be relieved for posting without obtaining specific orders from this office. The official, against whom any punishment is current, should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. A report in this regard should be submitted immediately.
12. The promotion in case of SC / ST officials is subject to verification of their caste status. Division concerned will process for verification immediately.
13. If the promoted officials refuse the regular promotion before becoming entitled to a financial upgradation, no financial upgradation under MACP shall be allowed as such he has not been stagnated due to lack of opportunities. If however, financial upgradation has been allowed due to stagnation and they subsequently refuse the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial upgradation. He shall, however not be eligible to be considered for further financial upgradation under MACP, till they agree to be considered for promotion again and the second and the next financial upgradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal.
14. The regional allotment is subject to change, if there is any variation in the vacancy position in any Region.
15. Copies of charge reports should be sent to all concerned and Circle Office in due course.
