Memo No. STA/2- PM GR-III/2018 dated at Chennai 600 002 the 23.05.2018

The competent authority has ordered the promotion of the under mentioned Postmaster Grade II Cadre official, to the cadre of Postmaster Grade III on regular basis in the in the Level-7 in Pay Matrix (PB-II Rs.9,300 –34,800 with Grade pay of Rs. 4,600/- Pre revised pay scale) as applicable to him as per the existing orders in force and further ordered his allotment to Region as shown against him with immediate effect and until further orders.

2. The promotion of the above mentioned official in Postmaster Grade III Cadre will take effect from the date on which the official actually joins the post in Postmaster Grade III Cadre.
3. Further career progression will be in the hierarchy in the Postmaster Cadre only as per the provisions in the relevant Recruitment Rules and not in General Line.
4. Officials who are promoted on regular basis are entitled to exercise an option for fixation of pay on promotion under FR 22 (1) a (1) on the date of promotion or on the date of accrual of next increment in the scale of pay in lower post. The option in this regard should be exercised within one month from the date of promotion. Option once exercised is final. The official now promoted on regular basis is not entitled for any pay fixation in the pay band and Grade pay applicable to PM Grade-III Cadre if he has already availed the benefit of financial upgradation under TBOP/BCR Scheme/MACP Scheme.
5. The Region concerned will issue transfer and posting orders within 3 days from the date of receipt of this order.
6. The Region will specifically mention in the Transfer and posting orders, whether the transfer will be for a period exceeding 180 days or not exceeding 180 days to ensure economy in expenditure on account of payment of TA/DA in case of the official retiring shortly on superannuation after joining the promotional post.
7. The appointing authority reserves the right either to modify or cancel the promotion, if the official is found not eligible for promotion as Postmaster Grade III or if found necessary for any cause at a later date. For such an order this will be the notice issued in advance. No separate notice will be issued whenever modification / revision / cancellation is ordered.
8. The declination, if any, will be disposed by the Appointing Authority concerned. In the case of official declining the promotion, no fresh offer of appointment on promotion shall be made for a period of one year from the date of refusal of promotion or till a next vacancy arises, whichever is later. On the eventual promotion to the higher grade, such Government Servant will lose seniority vis-à-vis his juniors promoted to higher grade earlier.
9. In case any Vigilance / Disciplinary case, of the type referred to in O.M. No. 22011/2/86 – Estt. (A) dated 12.01.88 and DOP&T circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25 – 19/88 – SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP &T Memo No. 22011/4/91 – Estt (A) dated 14.09.92 circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25 -19/88 – SPG dated 13.10.92 is pending against the above mentioned official, he should not be relieved for posting without obtaining specific orders from this office. The official, against whom any punishment is current, should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. A report in this regard should be submitted immediately.

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10. The promotion in case of SC / ST officials is subject to verification of their caste status. Division concerned will process for verification immediately.

11. If the promoted official refuses the regular promotion before becoming entitled to a financial upgradation, no financial upgradation under MACP shall be allowed as such he has not been stagnated due to lack of opportunities. If however, financial upgradation has been allowed due to stagnation and he/she subsequently refuses the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial upgradation. He/She shall, however not be eligible to be considered for further financial upgradation under MACP, till he/she agrees to be considered for promotion again and the second and the next financial upgradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal.

12. The regional allotment is subject to change, if there is any variation in the vacancy position in any Region.
