Memo No.STA/76-191/2017 dated at Chennai 600 002, the 08.12.2017

The Competent authority has ordered the promotion of the following Postal Assistant (SBCO), to the cadre of LSG (SBCO) on regular basis in the Level-5 in Pay Matrix (pre-revised Pay Band 1-Rs.5200-20200-Grade Pay-Rs.2800/-) as applicable to her as per the existing orders in force and further ordered the Regional allotment with immediate effect and until further orders.

2. The promotion of the said official will take effect from the date on which the official actually joins the post of LSG after the issue of this memo.

3. The official now promoted on regular basis is not entitled for any pay fixation if she had already availed the benefit. The official who is entitled for fixation of pay has to exercise an option under FR 22 (I) (a) (1). This should be exercised within one month from the date of promotion. Option once exercised is final.

4. If the official is already getting higher pay band / Grade Pay by virtue of financial upgradation under TBOP / BCR / MACPs, she may continue to get her present pay band / Grade Pay without any further fixation on promotion to LSG (SBCO) cadre ordered in this Memo.

5. The Postmaster General, Chennai City Region, Chennai will issue transfer & postings immediately and ensure the relief of the official to join in time in the new post.

6. The appointing authority reserves the right either to modify or cancel the promotion, if the official is found not eligible for the promotion or if found necessary for any cause at a later date. For such an order this will be the notice issued in advance. No separate notice will be issued whenever modification / revision / cancellation is ordered.

7. The official should be relieved immediately and directed to report to new place of posting. The responsibility would be that of the controlling officer.

8. The declination, if any, will be disposed by the appointing authority concerned. In the case of official declining the promotion, no fresh offer of appointment on promotion shall be made for a period of one year from the date of refusal of promotion or till a next vacancy arises, whichever is later. On the eventual promotion to the higher grade, such Government Servant will lose seniority vis-à-vis her juniors promoted to higher grade earlier.

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9. In case any Vigilance / Disciplinary case of the type referred to in the OM No. 22011/2/86-Estt. (A) dated 12.01.88 and DOP&T circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25/19/88-SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP & T Memo No. 22011/4/91-Estt (A) dated 14.09.92 circulated vide Directorate's Memo No. 25-19/88-SPG dated 13.10.92 is pending against the official, he should not be relieved for posting, without obtaining specific orders from this office. The official against whom any punishment is current should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment, and a report in this regard should be submitted immediately.

10. If the promoted official refuses to accept the regular promotion before becoming entitled to a financial upgradation, no financial upgradation under MACP shall be allowed as such he has not been stagnated due to lack of opportunities. If, however, financial upgradation has been allowed due to stagnation and he subsequently refuses the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial upgradation. She shall, however not be eligible to be considered for further financial upgradation under MACP, till she agrees to be considered for promotion again and the second and the next financial upgradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal.

11. It should be ensured that no Vigilance / Disciplinary case is pending against the official, while effecting LSG (SBCO) promotion. Relief of the official to the promotional post wherever necessary should be ordered by the Heads of Division / Unit only after satisfying the above points.

12. The regional allotment is subject to change if there is any variation in the vacancies in any region.
